# **INFORMATION SHEET – MOMS**

Below is some general information and guidelines for being a Mom in Gather.

## Meeting Time/Dates/Places

### There will be a Mom meeting on August 19. You will receive your Gather group information that night.

Gather meeting suggested start time is 6:00 pm. Group end times may differ somewhat, but keep in mind that children will need to be picked up from childcare no later than 8:30. Children can be dropped off at the church for childcare as early as 5:45 pm.

Childcare is provided the first Tuesday of the month (on most months). The scheduled childcare dates for 2021-2022 are:

## **Mom Guidelines**
