

INFORMATION SHEET - MOMS

Below is some general information and guidelines for being a Mom in Gather.

Meeting Time/Dates/Places

Gather meeting times will be 6:00 to 8:15 pm. Groups may differ somewhat, but keep in mind that children will need to be picked up from childcare no later than 8:30. Children can be dropped off at the church for childcare as early as 5:45 pm.

Childcare is provided the first Tuesday of the month. The scheduled childcare dates for 2020-2021 are:

September 9 (not the first Tuesday this month)

October 6

November 3

December 8 (Christmas Coffee-please encourage your group to attend. Childcare is for the Christmas Coffee only.)

January 5 February 2 March 3

April 7

May 5

Mom Guidelines

Moms are ladies that no longer have children in their homes. Exceptions will be made if your youngest child is in high school. Other exceptions will be considered.

Moms must be active members of First Baptist Forney, which includes attending a Sunday bible study class or being a volunteer in a children's or youth class.

Mom Expectations

It is expected that each Mom has had a time when she has accepted Christ as her Savior and followed with Biblical baptism. Hopefully, because of this, Moms will always be growing their personal relationship with Christ outside of Gather.

Each group will be expected to present the devotion as a part of your group time each month. This devotion will be provided to you and will be based on the Bible and how we women can be who God desires for us to be. This will not require a lot of extra preparation unless you desire to do so.

We will ask all Moms to cooperate with whatever decisions are made regarding gift giving, etc. These decisions will be made by all the Moms at a meeting in August. Though some do not understand why this is required, it is something we must do to avoid competition between groups. Sisters do compare from group to group.

Each group of Moms will be asked the maximum number of Sisters they would like to have in their groups. Please be honest and up front with this so that you are not overloaded. Groups will differ due to the size of homes or size of dining tables.
